

## **16 to 19 tuition fund**

ROC College applied for and was awarded 16 to 19 tuition funding in November 2020 through the ESFA and the Department of Education.

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is one-off funding and is ring fenced for schools, colleges and other 16 to 19 providers. The funding was made available to provide small group tuition for students between the ages of 16 and 19 in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted. Students who have not achieved a Grade 4 English and Maths, should be and have been prioritised within our planning.

ROC College, as with many other colleges across the UK, has felt the impact of the COVID 19 pandemic. The 16 to 19 funding has been used to help alleviate some of these. In particular the funding has been used to buy in addition tutoring in Maths and English. A number of students over the past months, have been isolating or shielding due to the pandemic and ROC College has responded to these changing needs. We have ensured that students have the opportunity to access face to face and remote learning on a 1-1 or small group basis. We regularly review the deliver to ensure the opportunities are accessible to all and adapt as necessary.

We maintain records of how the funding is being used and store this information in line with our GDPR policy.
